Registrars Meeting on 4/5/07

- One needs influential person to get one's FIR registered.
- Attempts are made to arrive at a compromise even in serious criminal offences for extraneous reasons.
- Non-registration is worse in rural police stations.
- About 10% of the cases investigated are the result of court intervention.
- NGOs participation required to rectify.

Prof. A. Narang: IGNOU Offers 24 hr. DD and FM Channel for Police








