Universities Propose Research for PhD Fellowships on

As a follow up of initiative of signing MoU with universities, BPR&D has awarded six Ph.D fellowship programs on Universities proposals. The Fellowships were awarded during a meeting held on 3rd August, 2007, in the BPR&D conference Hall under the Chairmanship of Director (R&D), BPR&D. The LNJN National Institute of Criminology and Forensic Science has been awarded two Fellowships on the Subjects "Human Rights Violation of Rape Victims in Delhi city" and "Sexual abuse of children: A Sociological Study in Delhi Metropolis". The Manonmaniam Sundarnar University ,Tamil Nadu will work on the subject of "Victims of Terrorism: An analysis of Bombay Bomb Blast in the post Babri - Masjid Demolition Period. Whereas, The University of Lucknow has been awarded the fellowship on "Impact Analysis of Prison Reforms". The Department of Legal of Studies, University of Madras has proposed the study on "CBI cases before Courts - An Analysis". While the Department of Politicial Science

University of Hyderabad will do the study on "Moral and Motivational Issues in Police Personnel: A study of Andhra Pradesh Police".

Fellowship Scheme:

- 1. At UGC rates.
- 2. The duration of the fellowship is for 3 years.
- 3. Fellowship value is Rs 8,000/- P.M for the first two years & Rs 9,000/- P.M for the third year.
- 4. Contingency grant of Rs 10,000/- Per year.
- 5. Departmental Assistance of Rs 3,000/-per year.
- 6. HRA and Medical benefits as per UGC rules.


