

### Understanding Indian Insurgencies



by DM Mitra, Director LNJN-NICFS

Shri DM Mitra while posted as Dy.Director at BPR&D went to Strategic Studies Institute of the US Army War College, US for 1.5 year. This book is a product of his research in association with this

institute. A simple linear model for India has been developed to demonstrate how the degree of inaccessibility of an area, the strength of separate social identity of its population, and the amount of external influence on the area determine the propensity of that area for insurgency. Implications of the Indian model for various aspects of counterinsurgency strategy for the Third World, including economic development, the role

of democracy, social and political autonomy, and counter insurgency operations are discussed. Recommendations for effective counter insurgency strategy and for long-term stability in these countries are included. ## Jaipur Police Station is World's No.1

SHIPRA PATH Police Station in Jaipur (Rajathan) is nation's pride. It has been selected the best Police Station in the world beating 450 contestants. modest post in Mansarovar Colony beat Nigeria in Africa and Los Angles in United States in the race to Number One. Brazil. considered best in South America, was runner-up. Shipra Path vied with outposts from 34 countries spanning five continents to be adjudged best with a score of 99 per cent.

"Altus Global Alliance" of the Netherland adjudged the entries. Altus, an alliance of six academic centers and non-government organizations, is headquartered in the Hague.

Shipra Path has also featured in India's top two Police Stations along with Ramganj in Jaipur city. It also became number one in Asia beating 167 posts.

Report on Comparative Rate of Imprisonment in Different Countries: Highlights

- It is generally alleged that prisoners in India languish in prisons for years together without trial.
- As against the total persons arrested in 2005, only 3.9% of under trial prisoners were awaiting trial.
- The Undertrial prisoners (as on 1.1.2005) in prisons are:
  - 78.3% for one year or below. 19.5% for 3 to 6 months.
  - 40.5% for 3 months or less
- per lakh of population (lower than 205 countries).

#### Women Police Uniform during Pregnancy

The Bureau after interaction with women police officers of all Central Police Forces. collected information from different States/UTs and in consultation with different rules in existence, has re-drafted the rules and re-designed the women police uniform at the time of their family way. PAs and PSs: Shri S P Gupta (88%), Smt. Neelam Gera (88%), and Shri Zile Singh, PS (87%).


