### **Police Act Drafting Committee meeting**



In pursuance of decision taken in the last Police Act Drafting Committee( PADC) meeting held on 24<sup>th</sup> September 2006, BPR&D held consultation with representatives of state police forces to discuss the proposed chapters on constabulary. Officers from 17 State Police Cadres attended the meeting on 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> October 2006.

In view of the diverse practices followed by different state police forces and diverse views and varying degrees of approval expressed by the groups, it is suggested that PADC may recommend that chapters on constabulary may not be adopted too rigidly by the states. In other words, states may decide suitable modification to the provisions depending on the present situation, educational levels, and other local situation. Hence we may consider rewarding the draft language of constabulary chapters.

#### 2. National Consultation on Federal Crimes

BPR&D had organized a **National Consultation on 9<sup>th</sup> October 2006** on **Federal Crimes** with references to the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in in Parkash Singh and others Versus Union of India and others at BSF Conference Hall, New Delhi. A good number of States and

#### 3. 21st meeting of the Standing Committee on Police Research

21<sup>st</sup> meeting of **the Standing Committee on Police Research** was held on 16<sup>th</sup> October, 2006 which was chaired by the **Union Home Secretary, Shri V. K. Duggal,**with it's follow up by Dr. G. S. Rajagopal, Special Secretary, MHA. It was decided in this meeting that a sub-group would be formed to streamline clearance of research proposals in one go.

#### **DEVELOPMENT**

Jammu and Kashmir Police prepared a report of **IED Blast trends and analysis** in Kashmir valley in the past four years. The scope of the study included the following:-

- I. Analyze Blast/Recovery of IED's data for past 4 years
- II. Study the trend and pattern of explosives used
- III. Concept of post blast investigation teams
- IV. Structure of State Bomb Data Centre

For the establishment of **State Bomb Data Centre at State level** in entire country it has been recommended for setting up of Post Blasts Investigation (PBI) teams at district level.

Standing Operative Procedure (SOP) for Police Stations to be followed and precautions/counter measures have also been suggested in the study.
