As part of the 50th Anniversary celebrations, a Golden Jubilee Souvenir was published along with a compendium on the best practices on handling of COVID - Indian Police Response to COVID-19 Crisis. A Postal Special Cover and My Stamp were also issued to commemorate the Golden Jubilee of the BPR&D. The Student Police Cadet (SPC) Programme got its website. All the Research Projects, completed between 2016 and 2020, were summarised in the Golden Jubilee Edition of the National Police Research Repository.

As we march ahead in the new year, let us leave behind the sufferings of the year 2020, caused mainly by COVID-19. We look forward with fresh hope and renew our resolve to live up to the trust of the citizens and serve the nation as frontline warriors and dedicated policemen.

7TH ALL INDIA POLICE HOUSING CONFERENCE

The **7th All India Police Housing Conference** was organized on the 08th & 09th December, 2020, at the BPR&D Hqrs., New Delhi, through video conferencing.

There were a total of 7 Sessions in this Conference, viz., Inaugural Session, followed by four Technical Sessions, Panel Discussion and, finally, the Valedictory Session. 15 lectures were delivered in the 4 Technical Sessions on the themes of Architectural Planning, Construction of Multi-storey Residential Quarters, Building Services, Tender Procedures and Maintenance

and Repair of Police Infrastructure. **Shri P.K. Gupta**, Chairman-cum-Managing Director, NBCC (India) Ltd., inaugurated the Conference on the 8th December, 2020, and the Valedictory Address was given by **Shri Durga Shanker Mishra**, Secretary, Housing and Urban Affairs, Govt. of India. on the 9th December. 2020.

POLICE COMMEMORATION DAY

Police Commemoration Day is observed on the 21st October every year to honour the supreme sacrifice of police personnel for the nation. It was on this day in 1959 when CRPF led a saga of valour and sacrifice in the inaccessible and inhospitable terrain of Hot Springs in Ladakh. BPR&D Officers and staff paid tributes to the martyrs on the occasion.

Shri Pawan Srivastava, IPS, Director CAPT, along with staff paid homage to Martyrs on Police Commemoration Day, 2020. A wreath-laying ceremony with two minutes of silence was observed.
