Digital Forensics at NCR&IC, CDTI, Hyderabad

CDTI Hyderabad conducted a two week offline course on 'Cyber Crime Investigation and digital forensics' at NCRI&CB Lab, from Nov 29 - Dec 10, 2021. 32 officials of the rank of SI to Dy. SP from 6 states attended the training.



During the period under review, five CDTIs and CAPT Bhopal conducted 108 online courses, in which 3147 personnel were trained. A broad spectrum of professional concerns, including 'Advanced Security and Prison Intelligence,' 'GIS & GPS Technologies,' 'Gender Sensitization,' 'Financial Crimes and Frauds,' 'Crime Scene Investigation,' 'e-Indian Technical Economic Cooperation Programmes on Cyber Security and Counter-Terrorism for Cambodian Police,' 'Digital Forensics,' 'Incident Response System,' 'Zero FIR,' 'Soft Skill,' 'Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Cases,' 'Dark & Deep Web,' 'Traffic Management,' 'Intellectual Property Rights, 'Technology in Prison Administration,' 'Juvenile Justice,' 'Investigation of Wild Life Crime Cases,' 'Terrorist Funding,' and 'Atrocities against SC/ST/ Weaker Section' etc., were deliberated among others.
